








A Joint Cooperation between the University of Anbar and the British Sterling Educational Foundation.

The University of Anbar Ranks the First among Iraqi Universities and the 146th Globally

The (UI Green metrics) Ranking has launched its version for the year 2022 to evaluate international universities in six axes, namely (infrastructure, energy and climate change, waste treatment, water resource management, transportation, education and scientific research). The University of Anbar has ranked the first among (77) Iraqi universities and the (146th) among (1050) international universities participating in this Ranking.






Centre for Renewable Energy Research Participates in Patents Exhibition

Prof. Dr. Rabah Nouri Farhan has participated with the patent entitled (Design and Implementation of a Smart Monitoring System on Iraqi Water Dams). In this patent, a smart monitoring system was designed and implemented on Iraqi water dams. A wireless sensor network system was developed to monitor the safety of the dam. The sensor network includes heterogeneous types of sensors distributed on different parts of the dam


about the safety of the dam. The sensor nodes are spread across the body of the dam and are linked to the central node. In addition, Asst. Instructor Nizar Ismat Sino has participated with the patent entitled (A New Method to Cool Refrigerated Freight Cars at a Low Cost). In this patent, a new refrigeration system was designed and implemented at an economical cost to cool refrigerated freight cars.

Students' Research Projects in the University of Anbar Achieve Top Positions Compared with Arab Students Participating in the Arab Creativity Forum


