

Second: Terms and conditions of admission.

- 1- The applicant should hold Iraqi secondary certificate or its equivalents.
- 2- The certificate of non-Iraqi studies is conditioned to the assessment by the ministry of Education \ General directorate of evaluation and examinations.
- 3- The applicant should not exceed three years since the graduation date from secondary school, for cultural exchange, the sons and wives of diplomats working in Iraq. While, they should not exceed four years from the date of graduation for the self-fund student in morning studies, with the exception of those conditions for students who are accepted in the evening studies.
- 4- The student must meet the minimum requirements for admission to the college or university where they wish to study, as specified in the application form in the order of requests.

The following are the minimal admission requirements:

90% for medical subjects.

80% for engineering /medical health technologies.

70% for pure science.

65% Law/Political Science.

60% for other majors.

- 5- Tuition fees are charged for students applying for admission on self-fund morning preliminary study specified in paragraph (3/first) as the fees charged for students approved on the morning private government education channel. Evening study students pay the same fees charged for evening students.
- 6- The applicants who are accepted into evening studies are excluded from the condition of graduation year.
- 7- The applicant has to submit a health certificate confirming that s/he is free of diseases, as well as passing the medical examination according to the conditions specific to each study.
- 8- At the starting of each academic year, the applicant or the official entity designated on his behalf shall pay the annual registration fee in foreign currency or its equivalent in Iraqi dinars, as per the terms of the executive programme between the two nations.

Third: Required documents and application dates.

A- Undergraduate Studies.

- 1- An authentication of secondary certificate verified by the issuing institute, the ministry of foreign affairs, and the Iraqi embassy in the applicant's country. While, the applicants who attained secondary school certificates from Iraqi schools should submit the certificates issued by the general directorate of education in the governorate where the applicants completed his\her study.
- 2- The original nationality I.D.
- 3- A copy of the passport.
- 4- Two (2) personal photos.
- 5- The application form for every program, which can be obtained by the authority that nominates the applicants, the Iraqi embassy or the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research. The applicant or the nominating authority should pay the study charges in the financial department at the ministry.

6- The application is open until 1st October 2022.

Scholarships for emigrants who have an equivalent certificate to the Iraqi secondary school

- 1- The application is only for non-Iraqi.
- 2- Only students from outside Iraq can apply, through the offices of Iraqi cultural attachés.
