The University of Anbar has achieved advanced rankings locally and internationally in the **Times Ranking of scientific disciplines**. The University has ranked the first locally in life sciences, computer sciences, and engineering, and the third in physics in the famous British Times Ranking.

The International Ranking Unit at the University Presidency announced that the British Times Ranking has officially launched today the version of the ranking for disciplines for this year. It indicated that the University's achieving these rankings within the Times Ranking, which is considered one of the most important global ranking systems, was a result of the scientific plans followed by the University Presidency and direct support by the President of the University, Prof. Dr. Mushtak Talib Saleh Al-Neda, members of the University Council, and the staffs of all colleges and faculties of the University, for the work of the International Ranking Unit at the University.

THE UNIVERSITY ISSUES UNIVERSITY ORDERS OF ADMISSIONS FOR 252 STUDENTS FROM 37 FOREIGN COUNTRIES.

Welcoming international students at its institutions....

The University of Anbar has issued university orders of admission for international undergraduate and postgraduate students in the various colleges of the University, with a total number of (242) undergraduate students and (10) postgraduate students from (37) different countries of the world. This experience is the first of its kind, and it comes within the (Study in Iraq) initiative launched by His Excellency the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research. It is one of the most important criteria in appraising our University institutions in the global ranking systems towards implementing the strategic plan to open up to international universities.



ACADEMICS COAUTHOR A BOOK PUBLISHED IN THE ELSEVIER INTERNATIONAL PUBLISHING HOUSE

Academics at the College of Applied Sciences–Heet/University of Anbar, namely, Asst. Prof. Dr. Rasem Farrag Muslim, Asst. Prof. Dr.. Mustafa Nadhim A'wai, Heet Directorate of Education, and a lecturer at the College, and Asst. Prof. Muwafaq Ayesh Rabia' have coauthored a book with academics and scholars

from the rest of the world>s topranking universities. The book is published in the Elsevier International Publishing House, which is indexed in Scopus and Web of Science. Academics at the College of Applied Sciences – Heet wrote two chapters of this book, which is entitled 'Advances in Nanotechnology-Based Drug Delivery Systems.

The President of the University has appreciated the efforts of the academics, hoping that all scholars at the University of Anbar will exert more efforts in authoring and publishing researches in global indexes to elevate the status of the University among Arab and international universities.



TWO STAFF MEMBERS FROM THE COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING OBTAIN A PATENT

Prof. Dr. Khaled Farouk Abdel Ghafour and Asst. Lecturer Laith Latif Hamed from the College of Science achieved the patent entitled (An Improved Method for Adopting the Analysis of the Level of Beta-Eristine Protein in the Blood as one of the Diagnostic Tests for the Detection of Type 2 Diabetes(. The research team was able to find an improved method to adopt the analysis of the level of Beta-Eristine protein in the blood as an additional diagnostic factor to determine diabetes mellitus and its complications (type 2) with good accuracy and sensitivity for use in the medical, research fields and in the diagnostic laboratories of the Ministry of Health. It is worth noting that the patent is the product of a joint team work amongst different Iraqi universities.

A RESEARCH TEAM FROM THE UNIVERSITY DOCU-MENTS THE HISTORY OF THE ISLAMIC WAQF IN ANBAR

Based on the directives of the presidency of the University of Anbar to affiliate with society and provide scientific and research services, researchers from the University of Anbar, staff members in the Department of History - College of Education for Humanities, documented the history of the Islamic Waqf (Endowment). This came during the formation of a research team based on the desire of the Islamic Endowment Directorate in the governorate. The study titled: "the Sunni Endowment in Anbar: A Documentary Study" and published in the twentieth volume / third issue / September 2023 of The Journal of University of Anbar for Humanities is to give a historical and cultural dimension to Anbar Governorate, and to demonstrate the role that the religious institution plays in spreading Islamic awareness and adopting the principle of moderation as an approach in its speech.



THE COLLEGE OF LAW AND POLITICAL SCIENCE HOLDS ITS 1ST SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE

Under the patronage of His Excellency the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Dr. Naim Al-Aboudi, and in the presence of Prof. Dr. Adnan Al-Jumaili, representative of the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, the Governor of Anbar Province, Dr. Ali Farhan, Dr. Yassin Al-Ithawi, Chair of the Education Committee in the Iraqi Parliament, Mr. Mayor of Ramadi, and a number of scientific figures, the College of Law and Political Science has held its 1st Scientific Conference entitled 'Legal and Political Reform in Iraq: Reality and Ambition'.

The conference began with the recitation of verses from the Holy Quran, then the Iraqi national anthem was played, and Surah Al-Fatiha was read to the souls of the martyrs of Iraq and Gaza. After that, a short film produced by the Department of Media and Government Communication at the University Presidency was displayed about the College of Law and Political Science. Then, a speech by the President of the University was delivered, in which he indicated that those in charge of the Conference made their first goals to identify



weaknesses and deficiencies in the legal and political field, diagnose them, then present proposals to address them in a way that contributes to the major reform process Iraq is witnessing. At the end of his speech, the President of the University thanked His Excellency the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research for sponsoring the Conference. He also thanked those in charge of the Conference, committees and

participants. The Conference also included speeches by the representative of His Excellency the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research and a speech by the Conference Chairperson, Dean of the College of Law and Political Science.

After that, the Conference sessions began to discuss a number of articles in the legal and political fields. The Conference aims to provide specialized scientific studies to diagnose weaknesses and deficiencies in the legal and political fields and propose appropriate solutions in a way that contributes to the major reform process Iraq is witnessing in order to reach a mature experience that achieves stability, prosperity, and societal peace, enhance intellectual cohesion among researchers in the College of Law and researchers in the Iraqi, Arab and foreign universities and create a scientific and cultural environment which aims at upholding the values of excellence and scientific distinction.



THE UNIVERSITY CONCLUDES A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF JORDAN

The University of Anbar has signed a memorandum of understanding with the University of Jordan. The University president of Anbar, Prof. Dr. Mushtaq Talib Al-Nida, and the President of the University of Jordan, Prof. Dr. Nathir Al-Obeidat signed a memorandum of understanding for the purpose of strengthening scientific and academic cooperation frameworks, exchanging expertise, conducting joint research, and participating in supervising postgraduate students> theses and dissertations, in addition to participating in applying for international grants, including the European Union grants. OPENING TWO IELTS CENTER AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ANBAR

The IELTS Centers were opened at the University of Anbar in the presence of His Excellency the British Ambassador Stephen Hitchen. This happened during his visit to the University. He was received in the University president's office with his accompanying delegation, whereby the University president gave a detailed description of the University of Anbar and its institutions, colleges and research centers. The discussion also addressed the destruction the University was exposed to in the previous time and how it was able, during a record period, to rebuild itself with the efforts of its members and supporting parties.
