3- Urban and Non- urban interest:

Nature which is the main source of aspiration for romantic poetry loses its effect in Victorian poetry to be a common source of aspiration. Victorian poets focus on city life rather than rural one. Themes and language are quoted from urban rustic life.

4-Morality:

Though morality is in decline in this era, poets do their utmost effort to regain morality. They encourage people to be true, noble and honest.

5- Objectivity:

Victorian poets shoulder themselves the responsibility of social reform. By reflecting the suffering of people.

6-Medievial myth:

Victorian poetry shows a great interest in mythic and chivalrous anecdotes.
