1. Simile is a direct comparison that can be recognized by using *as* and *like*. In *The Ancient Mariner* simile occurs clearly :

Day after day, day after day

We stuck, nor breath, nor motion;

As idle as a painted ship

Up on a painted ocean.

In the poem Lucy, Wordsworth compares the girl to the star:

Fair as a star when only one

is shining in the sky.

2. Metaphor is indirect comparison, the words like ,as are not used.

In the poem Lucy, Wordsworth doesn't say that the girl was like a violet.

A violet by a mossy stone

Half hidden from the eye.

The last three paragraphs in page18 explain how metaphor is used in the poems you have studied.

3. **Personification** occurs when inanimate objects are given a human form, or when they are made to speak.
