The images of the play:

- 1-When Mrs. X said to Miss Y "I feel sorry as when I saw a wedding party in Paris restaurant" When Mrs. X saw Miss Y is sitting alone in the corners café.
- 2- When you visit us my husband "Bob" could not stand you as when clothes do not quite fit"
- 3- You pulled out of me all thoughts, which have lain like in their cocoon"
- 4-"Now I am like a thief that so that when you awakened", I had what you had lost.
- 5-"You could not bend so, you broke like a dry reed". You could not learn from others.

The animal imagery:

- 1-A worm into an apple, ate and ate only left the shell wanted to escape from you but you were.
- 2-A snake which attracted a bird. You drag me down in the water.
- 3-A huge crab which was ready to seize its victims with its claws.
