I stopped to drink a coffee.

- (= I stopped doing something else in order to have a cup of coffee.)
- 3 I tried to sleep.
 - (= I wanted to sleep, but it was difficult.)

I **tried counting** sheep and **drinking** a glass of warm milk.

(= These were possible ways of getting to sleep.)
